

Fire Safety Policy

My Home is committed to ensuring a fire-safe environment on all our projects. We strive to prevent fire incidents through proactive measures, training, and compliance with national fire safety regulations. All site personnel are responsible for understanding and adhering to fire prevention and emergency procedures.

We shall:

- Lensure full compliance with the National Building Code (NBC) of India, the Fire Services Act, and other applicable fire safety regulations of the local Govt.
- Londuct mandatory fire safety training for all site personnel, covering the use of first aid firefighting equipment and emergency evacuation procedures.
- Implement a Hot Work Permit system for all hot work-related activities involving welding, cutting, or other fire-related tasks, including electrical with strict supervision and fire safety measures in place.
- Lensure proper installation and maintenance of fire extinguishers, temporary fire alarms, and hoses at key locations on the site, with monthly inspections for functionality.
- ♣ Store flammable materials, such as fuels and chemicals, in designated areas with clear signage and away from ignition sources.
- Regularly inspect electrical installations and wiring to ensure compliance with safety standards, and immediately repair any damaged or faulty equipment.
- Learly mark and maintain unobstructed evacuation routes and emergency exits across the construction site.
- Conduct fire drills biannually to practice emergency response and improve preparedness, with a review to identify areas for improvement.
- Report all fire-related incidents, conduct thorough investigations, and implement corrective actions to prevent future occurrences.
- Regularly audit fire safety practices, update policies based on findings, and adapt to evolving regulations and site conditions.
