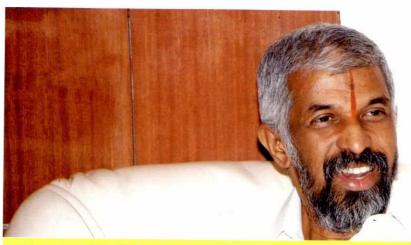

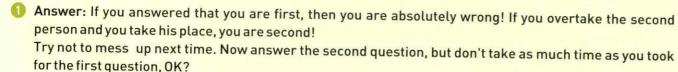

How should you assess your own health even before you develop complaints and seek doctor's advice?

Ask Your Own Self The Following Six Questions:

- 1. Am I able to have sound sleep for 6 hours in the night every day?
- 2. Am I able to have proper satisfactory, bowel movement daily in the morning without struggling with cup of tea coffee or Cigarettes etc.?
- 3. Do I have a good appetite and do I really feel happy and relish food?
- 4. Do I enjoy my whole day's work?
- 5. Is my chest measurement more than the abdominal girth?

If answers to all or any one the above questions are not in affirmation, it indicates that your health is not up to the mark and if you do not take proper care, you are heading for a serious health problem. You do not require any medicine at this stage. All you have to do is to follow the five health principles.

#### Five Principles:

- Take only two meals a day (for people between 20 not suffice, take fruits and salads as a third meal.
- Take a minimum of 12 (twelve) glasses (3 litres) of water intermittently between meals every day. This will take care of long gaps between meals, solves the problems of hyperacidity, duodenal ulcer, indigestion, constipation, piles and helps in preventing gall stones, kidney stones by maintaining optimum concentration of body fluids.
- III. A regular 30-45 minutes, yogic exercise every day as a part of your daily routine. Yoga is important in the sense that it gives exercise even to the vital organs to help in maintaining physical and mental health unlike in all other forms of exercise.
- IV. Remain on liquid diet (apart from 12 glasses of water) one full day in a week. liquid diet to be restricted to 4-5 glasses and it can be a milk, butter milk fruit juice, lime juice etc. This takes care of all your excesses in diet during the previous six days of the week and helps in avoiding excess weight, high cholesterol, high blood pressure and sugar problems.
- Pray or meditate twice a day to develop contentment and to carry on your duties meticulously. This keeps your conscious clear and gives peace of mind.

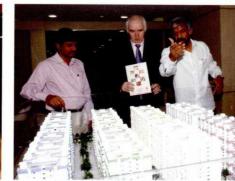
