INDUSTRY NEWS

India has huge potential in infrastructure and construction and the cement sector in India is set to receive a major boost. The Government of India is allocating funds to several infrastructure projects in the urban as well as rural areas, as per the Union Budget being announced recently in July 2014.

India's cement production has increased at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9.7 per cent to reach 272 million tonnes (MT) during FY 06-13. Presently, India is the second largest producer of cement in the world with a current capacity of around 370 MT which is expected to grow to 550 MT by FY 20.

In addition, there are a number of notable infrastructural projects already coming up in the country. The Indian cement industry, being the second largest in the world, is globally competitive. With the government of India providing enough scope in infrastructure development, there is lot of hope for growth in the cement sector.

Following the release of the Union Budget in July 2014, cement companies are hoping for some reforms like reduction in excise duties, which will go a long way in the betterment of this sector.

In addition, with the ever-increasing industrial activities, real estate, construction and infrastructure, and with the Special Economic Zones (SEZs) being developed across the country, the demand for cement in India is slated to increase in the upcoming years.

Acidity

Acidity can be treated by using following home remedy

Remedy1:

Fruit Remedy:

Eat Watermelon, banana or Cucumber each hour and fresh mint juice after meal. Eat a few almonds when your experience heartburn symptoms. This is good home remedy for Acidity.

Remedy2:

Water And Milk:

Gulp Coconut water 4-5 periods a day. Regular intake of one to two glass of a water early in the morning reduces acidity problems. Drink a glass of Cold milk for quick relief of heartburn and acidity.

Remedy3:

Herbal Tea Remedy:

One of the effective home remedies for acidity is Hearbal Tea containing spearmint(Pudhina) and liquorice(mulethi) is also helpful insted of normal tea, cofee.

Remedy4:

Jaggery And Clove remedy:

Stay a small part of jaggery (gur)in your jaws and slowly suck it. Repeat it each hour till acidity subsides. Along with this you can Acquire one piece of clove an suck on it gradually this will help to reduce acidity to great extent.

Remedy5:

Tulsi : A good home remedy for Acidity is to chew up a few basil(tulsi)leaves to obtain relif from blazing, nausea and gase.

Remedy6:

Vinegar: Taking mixture of two teaspoons of apple cider vinegar and two teasopoon of honey in a glass of of water before meal, will decrease the chance of acidity. otherwise intake of 1-2 tblespoons of whitw vinegar also provide finest acidity treatment.

9. Build human connections. Dedicate yourself to deepening your bonds with the people around you. Focus on helping others achieve their dreams, and be more concerned with selfless service rather than self-gratification. 10. Leave a legacy. The deepest longing of the human heart is the need to live for a cause greater than oneself.
