

My Home Industries has witnessed tremendous positive changes since the takeover of Sree Jayajothi Cements Ltd in 2013. With an able leadership and dedicated team, the forecasted benefits of the takeover has manifested over a very short span of time, and the cement sales has been witnessing a steady growth with record numbers being achieved month on month. Since the takeover, the Kurnool plant has facilitated easy and well strategized entry into new markets like Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Kerala.

With this acquisition our capacity stands at 8.4 MT per annum making us the largest producer in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. The growth is well reflected in the annual balance sheets and has a significant positive effect on the company's turnover. We conducted several dealer meets, mason meets, and other social activities in the last financial year which has considerably increased the visibility of our brand.

Our mobile vans are actively involved in educating people on best practices of construction at different work sites in different regions. Dealer initiatives and effective branding has also seen a new strategic shift and a heightened focus in the last financial year and the dealer network has expanded considerably pan India.

The management is of the opinion that these achievements have been possible through a joint effort of production and marketing and sales team with the support and co-operation from all other departments. The management hopes to see many more such achievements and continued growth over the years.



Construction NEWS:

A look into the current projects of My Home Constructions Pvt. Ltd spells good news, the last year like all other years so far has seen significant success due to the combined hard work and efforts of all the MHCPL Team. There are currently two on going major projects both of which are at significant locations. An overview of both the projects mentioned below re-affirms the My Home Spirit.

ABHRA:

The My Home Abhra project, spanning across an area of 5 acres of land with G+17 floors of luxury housing, is right at the heart of Hi-tech City, opposite to the Inorbit Mall. The project that started in May 2012 has a 28% ground coverage and the rest is beautifully landscaped. The 387 flats ranging from 2310 sft to 4650 sft are centrally air-conditioned. The project has all modern amenities and state-of-the-art technology with proper provision for parking and maintenance. The project also houses a 30,000 sft club house with facility for fitness and recreation. With construction on full swing, the project is progressing well as per the schedule and the total RCC work is completed and currently brickwork is under progress. The project which is scheduled for handover around March 2015 maintains world class construction quality and best available fittings, owing to which 85% of the flats are already sold off.

VIHANGA:-

Vihanga - synonymous with a Bird is all about scaling up, and that is what it exactly is for My Home Constructions. Vihanga started in May 2013 located at Wipro Junction, Gachibowli is home to spectacular 1996 flats spread over 21 acres. The 1996 flats housed at Vihanga range between 1115 to 2160 sq ft. This mega project has 30% ground coverage whereas the remaining 70% is beautifully landscaped. The project was designed to cater to the needs of urban customers and it sold a record 75% in just 8 months.

The project will have 20 blocks in a combination of ground-plus-14 and ground-plus-17 floors. About 16 blocks will have six flats in each floor, while the remaining 4 blocks will have seven flats in each floor. The size of two BHK units are in the range of 1,115 and 1,275 sq ft and the three BHKs measure between 1,690 and 2,160 sq ft. The four BHKs, also called sky villas, will have landscaped terrace. Vihanga's total built-up area will be around 3,500,000 sq ft.

As on date, 2 to 4 slabs in 8 blocks out of the total 20 blocks have been completed, while the remaining 12 blocks earth work is being executed.

There will be dedicated two-level parking which will accommodate about 3,400 vehicles. Amenities include a reception lounge, jogging track, outdoor play, landscaped areas, tennis courts, swimming pool and a skating rink. There will also be multipurpose halls, a clubhouse, gym, spa, guest rooms, convenience stores and a crèche

The project will also have wi-fi enabled areas, car wash area and automated billing for water, power, gas usage and maintenance. On the safety aspects, the project will have a fire alarm, fire sprinklers in individual flats and wet rises in parking and other common areas. It will also have a solar fencing and security system with motion sensor cameras in the common areas, intercom facility to all units connecting security.

The project will have power backup for all flats and common area excluding ACs and geysers. For water management, there will be rainwater harvesting facilities, sewage treatment plant and recycled water for flushing and gardening



Civil Supplies Minister D. Sridhar Babu on Sunday characterized the mega health camp organised by the Jeeyar Integrative Medical Services (JIMS) hospital as a "boon to the poor".

He said that the hospital, which had a humble beginning with just one doctor, had now spread its wings and was able to serve the needs of 2,000 patients. Rajan said that it was a rare that the hospital would get worldwide recognition in providing quality treatment.

Metro India director Vijaya Rajan said that the hospital had grown by leaps and bounds as the promoters, Jagjil brothers, were Good Samaritans. She thanked those who had helped in organizing the camp.
